## Golf Course News From the Superintendent

As temperatures rise and season comes to an end there is a lot of planning for this summer's maintenance and improvement projects.

With temperatures in the mid 90's the past two weeks our winter annuals are starting to decline, they will be removed right after easter in preparations for the summer annuals that will be installed the first part of May.



The restrooms on seven, fifteen and bocce will be renovated this summer during the course closures. Renovations will include electrical improvements inside each bathroom. There will be an exhaust fan, ceiling fan, new lighting, wiring replacement which will be located within the walls and ceilings, new tile floors, new plumbing fixtures, paint inside and out and the broken concrete walks will be removed and replaced with pavers on seven and fifteen. This work will be scheduled during the 18 days when the course is closed and should be able to be completed before the course reopens.



There will also be a lot of painting this summer. The concrete walls along Bonita Beach Road will be painted, all the columns and metal fencing along Bonita Grande and the North gate will be painted, as well as all the Master associations buildings. These two projects will

give Worthington a nice clean fresh look around the golf course and community.

There will also be an expansion to the Black, Blue and White tees on holes number five and seven as well as cart path replacement. Our summer closures will run May 27<sup>th</sup> through June 13<sup>th</sup> and August 4<sup>th</sup> through the 21<sup>st</sup>.
