Golf Course News From the Superintendent

The closure is just past the halfway point, and everyone is still working at full speed ahead. The bathrooms are about halfway done; the golf course aeration is in the final stretches and the painters are doing their best at dodging the rainstorms.

The pavers at the bathroom on number 15 are completed and I expect them to finish number 7 today. The electrical work is about 90 percent completed and will be finished after the painters are done. The plumbing is also about 90 percent completed and will be finished once the tile crew is done.



Tiling should be finished today with grouting tomorrow. The carpenters are working on installing the cement board ceilings and soffits so that stucco can be applied on Monday. Landscaping has been ordered for delivery on Tuesday and the cart path paving should be done Tuesday or Wednesday.



The greens aeration has been completed and we are now working on fairways, tees, collars and approaches one forward; this will take us 4 to 5 days depending on the weather. The rest of next week we will be working on mowing and rolling greens in preparation for

opening, as well as all the cleanup and detail work; followed by our Chipco Choice application on Thursday for mole crickets.

The painters have the pro shop and cart barn about 95 percent completed, they are working on cutting in edges, touch ups, and some other last details. From the front you can see the color scheme with a light creamy white base, a darker grey trim and a lighter grey accent color. They have started the club house and have prep work done on about 90 percent of it, they have applied primer to about 35 percent of the building and have started to paint the trim on the North and East sides today. Thank you for your patience as you may have to walk from one side of the building to the other when looking for an open entrance.



So far this month we have already had 2.45" of rain and we finished the end of May with 5.35" for the month. Lakes have come up about 10" since the middle of May. Once lakes reach 10' we will turn the fountains back on and return to normal irrigation schedules of twice a week. Remember to check Facebook for more updates this week.
