The 2025 winter/spring season has been a tremendous success. Much appreciation goes out to the members for their support and participation in the numerous events.

Also, a tremendous "THANK YOU" goes to all departments and staff for their hard work and dedication

throughout the 2024-2025 season, creating outstanding events that were well attended and enjoyed by members, member's families, and guests.

If you are heading North or have already done so, please let the Administration Staff know that you would like your address changed to your Northern address, so you do not miss out on any important mail.

As we enter the summer season, we would like to remind everyone that Hurricane Season has officially started and runs through November 30. We always hope that it will be an uneventful period, however, it is important to always stay vigilant and be prepared. Please review Worthington's Hurricane Preparedness Plan, available on the Worthington Website.

We are now in full swing of our summer season, and we have many events for the members who live here throughout the summer. Please see the weekly email blasts and the WCC website for event information and announcements.

Food and Beverage, Golf, and Activities are preparing their event calendars for the 2025-2026 season. Once professionally printed, they will be available in the clubhouse, pro shop, and administration building, as well as on the website.

The 2026 budget process will begin this June. Each department has begun preparing their Key Budget Assumptions and hours of operations.

In April 2022, we utilized Shell Consulting Group, LLC of Naples, to Amend the second and third quarters of 2020's employee tax filing to obtain Employee Retention Tax Credits, which the club was entitled to. Shell Consulting Firm completed the two 941A's. One for the second quarter of 2020 and another for the third quarter of 2020.

Worthington received a total of \$302,056 and paid the 20% contingency fee of approximately \$59,000. Engaging a qualified firm that was preparing Covid filings to do this work on a contingency agreement provided a net benefit to the club of \$243,000.

In March 2023, we informed the Finance Committee and the Master Board that we would be filing amended 941A's for the fourth quarter of 2020 and the First through Third quarters of 2021 on a contingency basis as well. The Amended 941A's were completed and filed in June 2023.

We received \$1,059,769 and will pay the 20% contingency fee of \$184,285, providing a net benefit to the club of \$875,484.

# Course Record - News from the Golf Thop

Summer is here, and it is a great time for golf at Worthington Country Club!

Reciprocal golf season is underway, and we have a great list of local courses to choose from. This year we have also joined a group of courses that are doing a \$35.00 rate for Worthington members. Stop by the golf shop or check out my weekly

Thursday blast for this list of discounted reciprocals.

The best way to see what is happening in golf is to check out my weekly e-blast that is sent by Administration each Thursday. There are useful links and remember to click the "Read More" button to see everything that is going on.

We are emphasizing pace of play. The Rangers will instruct each group to keep up with the group in front of you. The first violation will result in a warning, 2nd violation will result in the PGA Pros coming out and having that group skip a hole, a 3rd violation will result in the group being asked to leave the golf course.

The driving range will be "mats only" every Sunday all year round. Range balls are available on the driving range seven days a week from 7:00am-5:00pm.

Would you like your golf scores to go down? Who wouldn't? My "Tip from the Head Golf Professional" this fall is to work on your footwork and weight transfer during the golf swing. We see faults in these two areas for most players that are struggling to make consistent solid contact. When we begin to swing the club back our weight should transfer to the back foot and the back hip rotates behind you. Then, to begin the downswing transfer the weight to the front foot and let the forward hip rotate behind you as you swing the club down to hit the ball. Work on this weight transfer and footwork and I promise you will hit the ball better immediately!

To keep our Country Club atmosphere, please ensure that all golfers and their guests are always in proper golf attire on both the course and all practice areas.

If you see something going on in a golf area that you think is wrong during the hours of 7:00am-5:00pm, please let the Golf Shop at 239-495-1750 know right away. If it is after those hours, please email me at headpro@ worthingtoncc.net. Please take pictures of the incident. Without pictures or a phone call it can be almost impossible to do anything about it. It takes all of us here at Worthington CC to make our community strong.

The Worthington 24/25 golf season is coming to an end, and as we get to the end of May, the summer season of maintenance will begin. There are a lot of things that we will be working on this summer, and like in the last few years, greens are one of the most important. But the greens alone are not the only thing on our list; we will be making some

improvements to a few tee's around the course, working on landscaping projects around the clubhouse and on the golf course, and renovating the golf course bathrooms. In the common grounds, all the buildings, walls, and fencing will be painted, as well as bocce sideboard replacement and the resurfacing of tennis courts 1-4.

The closure schedules this summer will be as follows: CLOSED May 27th through June 13th, OPEN June 14th through August 3rd, and CLOSED August 4th through August 21st. The driving range mats will be open to the members as a convenience but will be closed for short periods of time as we work on the tee itself. The putting and chipping greens will open early, typically five to seven days before the course reopens. The proshop once again has a long list of reciprocals for members so they can play other courses.

As work progresses through the closures, we will post updates during the summer so members can see and understand the time and equipment that is used during each process, along with some before and after shots of the summer projects; stay tuned to the weekly newsletters to come.

With the season coming to an end for those who are leaving we wish you a safe and wonderful summer!  As a reminder, please see the below closing tips: Put a clean filter in your air conditioner and set the temperature as advised by your A/C vender with controls on "Auto" and "Cool". Set humidistat according to the Guidelines set forth by your A/C vendor. Thoroughly clean rugs and floors so as not to attract insects that will leave stains if they die there.	Place lanai furniture and all items that will mildew or rust indoors where there is air conditioning. Take care not to place on rugs, as this will leave marks. May want to place on cardboard or sheet to protect the carpet. Notify Post Office and Hoa Office and arrange for mail forwarding. Arrange for utility bills to be paid directly through the bank. Notify Telephone Company to put the phone on vacation status. Remove all trash in house and garage. Take to the main dumpster at Club House, if necessary. Do not use dumpsters				
Do not leave crackers, cookies, cereal, or other opened boxes in cabinets or on counters (may be stored in the refrigerator). Remember the crumbs in the toaster! Check your plumbing system for leaks. Look for wet areas or water stains in your kitchen, bathroom, and laundry	in condo areas. Anyone caught using condo dumpsters who is not a condo resident will be charged the Onyx fee. Prop the dishwasher door and the washing machine lid or door slightly open. May use folded paper towel to prop open.				
Turn off the water valve to your unit—by the hot water tank in the storage room. Before turning off the valve, fill all water traps and seal (leave in the closed position) to avoid evaporation. Turn off the main valve (outside) by Bonita Springs Utilities at 1-800-583-1496.	Weather strip and caulk windows and doors. Make sure all windows and doors are securely closed and locked (including patio doors and lanai screen door). Close blinds, roll shutters down, and leave the switch in the middle position.				
Replace any worn shut-off valvesCheck water heater for rustClean all toilets, flush and treat with a few capfuls of bleach to keep them clean and seal with plastic wrap to prohibit evaporation. A home caretaker may want to open, brush, and flush and then retreat and seal several times over the season. (If the main valve was turned off, a caretaker would need to turn it on and then off when finished.) Disconnect appliances — VCRs, TVs, computers, Garage door openers, and microwave ovens, turn off the water to the water heater. Leave the refrigerator "ON". Condiments and other non-perishables can be placed inside. Set at lowest settings — "1" and "A." Turn off ice maker and empty out all ice cubes. Place baking soda in both the fridge and freezer to control odors. If you choose to unplug the refrigerator, prop the door open. Special Note: Please remember that Florida is Tropical –summers are hot and humid, and these special steps are important to protect the investment of you and your neighbors.

# Chef's Corner CAMERON HORD

## Bourbon Glaze



This recipe for bourbon glaze makes a great marinade and glazing sauce for ribs, salmon, and chicken on your summer BBQ. We use it at the club frequently.

The Recipe is as follows:

- 15oz jar of orange marmalade
- 2 cups of brown sugar
- ½ cup of white vinegar
- 1 cup of orange juice
- 1 cup of soy sauce
- 1/2 cup of Mae Ploy sweet chili sauce
- 2 cups of bourbon whiskey (allow to warm up, not cool down if refrigerated)

In a saucepan, combine ingredients on low heat and simmer for about 30 minutes, stirring frequently. Watch as the sauce cooks; it will thicken and possibly boil over if not stirred; it should have a syrupy consistency when ready. Cool down; this sauce can be stored at room temperature indefinitely. If refrigerated, allow it to cool down to room temperature before use, as it will thicken when cold. When used as a marinade, a little goes a long way. Figure about half a cup per pound of meat or fish. You may need to add a little salt when grilling according to your taste. As a glaze, season meat or fish as desired. Cook to just shy of desired doneness, brush glaze liberally on both sides, and allow about 5 minutes per side to caramelize and enjoy!














# Lickleball Today
